Presentation Title: "American Woodcock Habitat and Life Cycle"

As the Upland Game Bird Specialist and Program Leader for the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, he is responsible for statewide conservation and management programs for ruffed grouse, American woodcock, sharp-tailed grouse, quail, pheasants, and wild turkeys. He has been involved with teaching wildlife management for Study Abroad classes in Africa and Russia, oversees the largest American woodcock chick banding program in the world, and is the only person to have captured all the species and sub-species of wild turkeys. He has contributed to international and national management activities for upland game birds and has received numerous awards for his contributions. Al is a charter member of the Michigan Chapter of the Wildlife Society and is a past president.
